His current internship is at Wycliffe—JAARS (Jungle Aviation And Radio Services) in Waxhaw, North Carolina, which is about an hour and a half southeast of us. In addition to providing aviation and radio services, the organization, whose main campus is based in Orlando, Florida, provides counseling services to missionaries. This provides us the opportunity to learn more about the organization and whether we want to be affiliated with them when we go
